Pilgrimage to Spain, Lourdes and Fatima

Monday June 19th: Depart from Newark airport at 7h20pm for Barcelona direct flight on United Airlines.

Tuesday June 20th: BARCELONA – MONTSERRAT- LOURDES

Arrive Barcelona at 9:05 am and after clearing customs we are met by your Tour Escort/Guide and travel to Montserrat, to Our Lady of Montserrat where you will have Mass. (Renewal of wedding vows). The statue of the Black Virgin of Montserrat was carved by St. Luke around 50 AD and brought to Spain. St. Ignatius Loyola made a pilgrimage to Montserrat after being injured in war, and it was soon after that he wrote his famous *Spiritual Exercises*. We continue on to Lourdes for dinner and the candlelight procession.



Wednesday June 21st: LOURDES

After breakfast your Tour Escort will take you on a tour in the footsteps of Saint Bernadette to visit the places like the cachot, the paternal home, and more. You return to the hotel for lunch and the afternoon is free for devotion and bath at the Grotto. Dinner at the hotel followed by candlelight procession.



Thursday June 22nd: LOURDES – LOYOLA- BURGOS-

After breakfast you drive to the Sanctuary of Loyola to visit the birthplace of Saint Ignatius and see the chapel of his conversion and more. Mass will be in Loyola followed by lunch.



After Lunch continue on to Burgos the beautiful *Catedral de Santa María de Burgos* (St. Mary's Cathedral of Burgos). The tomb of El Cid and his wife doña Jimena have been located in the transept since 1921. We see the magnificent Escalera Dorada (golden staircase) and more. Dinner and overnight in Burgos.

Friday June 23rd: BURGOS – SEGOVIA – AVILA



Today travel to Segovia, city where Isabella I, the Catholic, was proclaimed Queen of Castile. We visit the Carmelite Monastery to pray at the tomb St John of the Cross (Doctor of the Church). Mass in the Church

After Lunch, visit the Cathedral, The Alcazar and the Old quarter, admire the Roman Aquaduct before continuing to

Avila for dinner and night in the walled city.



Saturday June 24th: AVILA – LOS CUATRO POSTES (outskirts of Avila) – ALBA DE TORMES – SALAMANCA-

Visit the Monastery of the Incarnation and see the Cell of the Saint- the Convent of Saint Teresa of Avila, birthplace of the Saint, the Cathedral- Lunch in Avila.



Continue on to Alba de Tormes with a stop at the site of Los Cuatro Postes just outside Avila. In Alba de Tormes visit the Carmelite Convent with the tomb of Saint Teresa and see the relics of her heart and her left arm. Continue on to Salamanca for a typical Spanish dinner "Paella and sangria". Overnight in Salamanca.

Sunday June 25th: SALAMANCA - FATIMA

Visit the Old quarter, Main Square and the Old and New Cathedrals.

It was constructed between the 16th and 18th centuries in two styles: Lunch in Salamanca- continue to Fatima for dinner and home for the next 3 nights. Join the candlelight procession.



Monday June 26th: FATIMA with excursion VALINHOS and ALJUSTREL



This morning discover the village of the Seers with the homes of the Shepherds, the church and more. The Sanctuary, the Chapel of the Apparitions. Return to the hotel for lunch and afternoon is free for devotion etc.. Dinner at the hotel followed by the candlelight procession.

Tuesday June 27th: FATIMA excursion LISBON

Today visit the Birthplace of Saint Anthony who died in Padua Italy- see some of the sights of Lisbon and on the way back stop at Santarem to venerate the oldest Eucharistic Miracle and have Holy Mass in the Church of the Miracle- return to Fatima for dinner followed by the candlelight procession.

Wednesday June 28th: FATIMA – LISBON- RETURN HOME

We leave with the many graces received on the pilgrimage, and memories close to our heart. Transfer to airport for return flight at 10h25am. Arrive back in Newark at 1h15pm .
